Sub: Application for letter of permission for functioning of Dr. Maalakaraddy Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Mahadevappa Rampure Marg, Sedam Road, Kalaburagi, Karnataka-585105, for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 24 seats for M.D (Hom) in 05 subjects with 06 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 06 seats in Homoeopathic Philosophy, 06 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine and 03 seats in Paediatrics for the academic year 2024-2025-regarding.

Sir,

Dr. Maalakaraddy Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Karnataka, is functional since 1980 and has applied for permission for sanction of BHMS course with 100 seats and 24 seats for PG M.D (Hom) in 05 subjects with 06 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 06 seats in Homoeopathic Philosophy, 06 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine and 03 seats in Paediatrics for the academic year 2024-25. The College has submitted the Part 1 information in which the entire functional profile has been narrated. The Medical Assessment and Rating Board has examined the profile of the College as to whether the college fulfils the Minimum Essential Standards to be fulfilled as per the prevailing regulations under clause 28 of NCH Act 2020.

On careful examination of the report, the Medical Assessment and Rating Board has observed following shortfalls:

1. Acquittance roll of the faculty is not legible. College shall submit a legible copy of acquittance roll of last 3 months.
2. Acquittance roll and attendance of guest faculty is not uploaded. College shall submit the acquittance roll and attendance of last 3 months for verification.
3. Attendance and acquittance roll of modern medicine consultant is not uploaded. College shall submit the copy of attendance and acquittance roll of modern medicine consultants for last 3 months for verification.

IPD and OPD case records should be maintained with demographic details of the patient such as Name, Age, Sex, Address, Phone number, etc. Diagnosis of the case shall be recorded as per ICD 11 criteria. All follow up attendance should be recorded on the case records. Case sheets shall be maintained with complete case history, analysis and evaluation and repertorisation and made available in Medical Record Room for academic purpose of students and follow up of patients

Considering the above observations and facilities available, MARBH has decided to issue **Conditional Permission to Dr. Maalakaraddy Homoeopathic Medical College and Hospital, Mahadevappa Rampure Marg, Sedam Road, Kalaburagi, Karnataka-585105, for continuing BHMS course with intake capacity of 100 seats and 24 seats for M.D (Hom) in 05 subjects with 06 seats in Homoeopathic Materia Medica, 06 seats in Homoeopathic Philosophy, 06 seats in Repertory, 03 seats in Practice of Medicine and 03 seats in Paediatrics for the academic year 2024-2025.**

All deficiencies noticed shall be rectified within a period of one month and the compliance report shall be submitted for verification.

It is further to mention that all admissions shall be made from NEET/AIAPGET qualified candidates only. It is further informed that minimum 15% of undergraduate seats and 15% of postgraduate seats of the permitted intake capacity of 100 UG seats and 24 PG seats shall be treated as All India Quota. The counseling for seats under All India Quota shall be conducted by respective counseling authority of State/UT Govt. as designated by Central Government /NCH for the A.Y. 2024-25 and counseling for the remaining 85% seats or as the case may be, shall be conducted by the concerned Counseling Authority of that State/UT.

The Category wise list of the selected candidates may be informed to the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy after the process of admission is completed. Any admissions carried out other than NEET/AIAPGET qualified students will not be approved by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board.

Permission to college can be withdrawn or denied in the subsequent year if college is found deficient in compliance to MSR 2013 anytime during the academic year.
